



**A RESOLUTION OF THE
HAYS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
CALLING FOR WATER CONSERVATION**

WHEREAS, HAYS COUNTY HISTORICALLY EXPERIENCES PERIODIC DROUGHTS WHICH CAN BE BOTH PERSONALLY AND FINANCIALLY DEVESTATING, AND

WHEREAS, DRAMATIC GROWTH HAS STRESSED OUR FINITE WATER RESOURCES EVEN FURTHER, BUT SENSIBLE, COOPERATIVE EFFORTS CAN LESSON THE IMPACTS,

NOW, THEREFORE, HAYS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT CALLS ON ALL OF ITS CITIZENS TO VOLUNTARILY COMPLY WITH THE FOLLOWING:

1. FULL COMPLIANCE WITH ALL DROUGHT MANAGEMENT PLANS
2. ELIMINATION OF GROUND WATER USE FOR ALL DUAL WATER SOURCE RESIDENTS AND DEVELOPMENTS
3. ALL NEW SUBDIVISIONS TO USE SURFACE WATER ONLY, WHEN AVAILABLE, AND DEED RESTRICT LANDSCAPES TO NATIVE-DROUGHT TOLERANT SPECIES
4. ELIMINATION OF WATER FEATURES DURING DESIGNATED DROUGHT STAGES
5. UTILIZE RAINWATER HARVESTING TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT POSSIBLE
6. REPAIR ALL PLUMBING LEAKS AND DEVELOP FAMILY USE PRACTICES TO REDUCE DAILY CONSUMPTION




